*To Clean, Disinfect and Deodorize Toilet Bowls by Fast Acting Contact Action:* Remove water from bowl with mop or by forcing water over trap. Squeeze water from mop and place mop in bowl. Saturate mop with CLEANER and swab bowl all over, especially under the rim at water outlets. Flush and rinse mop.


*To Clean, Disinfect and Deodorize Urinals:* Hold mop over trap and saturate with CLEANER. Swab all surfaces including water outlets at top and grooves. Remove screen and pour 3 to 5 ounces of CLEANER in drain. Let stand approximately 3 minutes. Swab drain and replace screen. Flush and rinse mop.

*For Disinfecting Purposes Only:* Pour 2 to 4 ounces of CLEANER into bowl water. Swab commode seat and cover with solution. Flush toilet and rinse mop several times. Then rinse seat thoroughly and wipe dry.
