## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

In a typhoid sick-room, in the disinfecting of beds, clothes, utensils, typhoid stools and rooms, the Disinfectant should be used in the proportion of four ounces in each gallon of water.

**GARBAGE:** Sprinkle with the Disinfectant solution in the proportion of four ounces in each gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

**FLOORS:** When mopping or scrubbing use four ounces of the Disinfectant in each gallon of water.

**KITCHEN SINKS:** Scrub above and beneath the sink, the sides and edges of the sink itself, using a solution of four ounces in each gallon of water and flush the pipe with the remainder of the fluid.

**WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS:** Flush the closet and urinal bowls regularly with a solution made of 1 cupful in one gallon of water, leaving the solution in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution.

**GENERAL DISINFECTION:** Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part of the Disinfectant to 80 parts of water.

Because of its pleasant odor, Sano-Pine Disinfectant is admirably adapted for use in KITCHENS as a deodorant and deodorant, and, by using the solution of one part of the Disinfectant to 60 parts of water will aid in eliminating many food odors.

Sano-Pine Disinfectant is far more potent than any other Civil War Era Cleanser disinfectants so that they are not toxic, non-corrosive, non-irritative, do not stain, and are comparatively cheap, are not affected appreciably by acids.
