GENERAL INFORMATION

USES:

1. GENERAL WEED CONTROL IN NON-CROP AREAS: Controls broadleaf weeds, brush, and grasses. Kills most annuals and top kills perennials. It kills through the leaves only.

2. GENERAL WEED CONTROL IN SHRUB AREAS: Chemical will not injure desirable plants as long as spray does not come in contact with leaves of these plants. Chemical becomes inactive on contact with soil, therefore, plant roots do not take up chemical and chemical does not build up and become toxic at a later date.

3. GENERAL VEGETATION CONTROL: Around buildings and other installations, ornamental gardens, walkways, patios, storage areas, beneath greenhouse benches, fence lines, golf courses (sand traps), parkways, driveways, ditches, and other areas where any type of vegetation is undesirable.

4. AQUATIC WEED CONTROL: Both surface and sub-surface in ponds, lakes and ditches.

CAUTION

This product is toxic to wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Treatment of dense weed areas can result in oxygen loss from decomposition of dead weeds. This loss can cause fish suffocation. Therefore, to minimize this hazard, treat 1/3 to 1/2 of the water area in a single operation and wait at least 10 to 14 days between treatments. Begin treatment along the shore and proceed outwards in bands to allow fish to move into untreated areas. Consult your State Fish and Game Agencies before applying this product to public waters. Do not apply to muddy water.
