CONTROLS WEEDS AND GRASSES
BY CONTACT AND ROOT ACTION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Injury or loss of desirable trees or other plants may result from failure to observe the following: Do not apply, drain or flush equipment on or near desirable trees or other plants, or on areas where their roots may extend or in locations where the chemical may be washed or moved into contact with their roots. Do not use on lawns, walks, driveways, tennis courts or similar areas. Prevent drifts of spray to desirable plants. Do not contaminate domestic waters. Keep from contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Thoroughly clean all traces of this concentrate from application equipment immediately after use. Flush tank, pump, hoses and boom with several changes of water after removing tips and screens (clean these parts separately).

This weed killer is a ready-to-use solution designed to be applied undiluted as a spray on non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired. The degree of weed control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of product used, soil type, rainfall and other conditions. Apply any time of year except when the ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after predominant species are well established in late spring or early summer. Before treating, calibrate equipment to insure uniform coverage of area to be treated. Measure out the proper amount and apply. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas, such as: parking lots, fence rows, loading ramps, railroad sidings, storage yards, around buildings and industrial plant sites, apply 2-5 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (80-220 gallons per acre). To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, ryegrass, wild oats, crabgrass, cheatgrass, broomsedge, ragweed, lambsquarter and turkey mullein, apply 1-2 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (40-80 gallons per acre). For other hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses, such as Johnsongrass, saltgrass, bouncing bet, bracken fern and horsetail, apply 3-5 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (120-220 gallons per acre).

EQUIPMENT: Power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, knapsack sprayers or an ordinary sprinkler can be used to apply. No dilution or agitation is required.
