Your Submission Dated January 3, 1995

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. As directed in the Propoxur Data Call-In (issued July 13, 1992), the following sprayer restriction must be added to the Directions for Use section of the label:

"Do not apply this product using a trigger pump sprayer."

Additionally, amend the first sentence of the Directions for Use (which follows the General Misuse Statement; "It is a violation of...") to read as follows:

"This insecticide is ready to use undiluted from the can and must be applied using a compressed air sprayer."

2. Move the following sentence from the front panel and place it below the heading "Physical and Chemical Hazards:"

"Do not use, pour, spill, or store near heat or open flame."

The Physical and Chemical Hazards section should follow the Precautionary Statements section (ie. after the Statement of Practical Treatment).

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This insecticide is ready to use undiluted from the can and may be applied with either power operated or hand sprayers. Apply a coarse spray to infested surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste material.

This product is a highly effective formulation which provides rapid kill of crawling insects as listed below, including those resistant to certain chlorinated hydrocarbon and phosphate insecticides.

Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millipedes, Mosquitoes, Roaches, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders.

In addition to rapid kill, the solution stays on the treated surfaces and gives long residual activity. It is designed for use in food processing plants, warehouses, restaurants, motels, institutions and industrial plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use.

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

INDOOR USE: Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Scorpions. Waterbugs - Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact the treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly dry.
