

GENERAL INFORMATION USES

This product is designed for general vegetation control around buildings, and other installations, ornamental gardens, walkways, patios, storage areas, fence lines, golf courses (sand traps), parkways, driveways, drainage ditches and similar areas where any type of vegetation is undesirable.

1. **GENERAL WEED CONTROL IN NON-CROP AREAS:** Controls broadleaf weeds, brush and grasses. Kills most annuals and top kills perennials. It kills through the leaves only by interfering with photosynthesis within green plant tissue.

2. **GENERAL WEED CONTROL IN SHRUB AREAS:** Avoid spray drift to desirable plants during application as injury may result. This product will not injure desirable plants as long as spray does not come in contact with leaves of these plants. This product becomes inactive on contact with soil; therefore, plant roots do not take up chemical. This product does not build up and become toxic at a later time.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Avoid contamination of food and feed. During application, avoid drift to adjacent food and forage plantings that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption. Keep livestock out of treated fields. Wash sprayer immediately after application with detergent and water, then rinse with clean water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants in non-crop and non-timber areas only. Not for use on crops, timber, or other plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

NON-CROP OR NON-PLANTED AREAS: To kill above ground weed growth around buildings and other installations, ornamental gardens, walkways, patios, fence lines, golf courses (sand traps), parkways and driveways for control of undesirable broad-leaved and grass-type weeds - 2-1/2 gallons per 20 gallons of water (16 oz. per gal. water). Apply for full coverage and thorough weed contact. Apply preferably to young growth and up to seeding of weeds. Repeat applications as necessary to maintain control, particularly on grasses and established weeds. Avoid spray contact with foliage, food crops or ornamental plants. Do not water treated areas for 24 to 36 hours after application.

FOLIAGE SPRAY TREATMENTS

Non-Crop or Non-Planted Areas: Fence lines, buildings, fuel storage areas, rights-of-way, barrier strips, equipment areas, walkways, driveways and similar locations. Foliage spray treatments should be applied by diluting 5 to 10 gallons of this product to 100 gallons of water. Apply for full coverage and thorough weed contact. Apply to young weeds since control decreases as weeds mature. Weed plants should be succulent and actively growing for best results. Retreatment may be necessary to control grasses and established weeds. Avoid spray contact with foliage of food crops or ornamental plants. Local conditions may affect the use of this chemical. Consult agricultural experiment station or extension service weed specialist for specific recommendations for dosage, time of application and control of specific weeds. Do not apply at rates higher than those on this label. Check with state authorities for necessary permits.

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS

For 4 days following applications to non-crop areas (other than aquatic or residential sites), do not allow employees to have contact with the treated plants, except for contact with their footwear. For spot-treatment applications to residential sites, do not allow people or pets to touch treated plants until the sprays have dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store with or near feed, foodstuffs or drinking water. Keep container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures.

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FIRST AID
