

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use as a disinfectant around hospitals, hotels, motels and schools: Use 3 ounces of disinfectant to each gallon of water. Apply with a mop or rag on floors, walls and woodwork. Contact time must be at least 10 minutes for disinfection.

As a deodorant spray: Use 4 ounces of disinfectant to each gallon of water.

For Athlete's Foot fungus control on environmental surfaces: Use a dilution of 2 ounces disinfectant to 1 gallon water. Scrub shower stall floors, rubber and plastic bath mats, locker room runways, benches and all surfaces contacted daily by bare feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
