DIRECTIONS

For Use As A Disinfectant Around Hospitals, Hotels, Motels, and Schools: Use 3 oz. of Disinfectant to each gallon of water. Apply with a mop or rag on floors, walls and woodwork to be disinfected.

As A Deodorant Spray: Use 4 oz. of Disinfectant to each gallon of water.

Athlete's Foot Fungus Control on Environmental Surfaces: Use a dilution of 2 oz. disinfectant to 1 gallon water. Scrub shower stall floors, rubber and plastic bath mats, locker room runways, benches and all surfaces contacted by the bare feet each day.

CAUTION:

If concentrated Disinfectant is swallowed, administer emetic, such as a tablespoonful of mustard in a tumbler of warm water, and call a physician.

Avoid getting concentrate in eyes. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Harmful if swallowed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

Avoid contamination of food.

USE DIRECTIONS

FOR CL JING

Lightly Soiled Areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 4 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily Soiled Areas - mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 6-8 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 4 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 6-8 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water and then disinfected. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality.

To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas where fungicidal action is required, mop area with a solution containing 4 ounces per gallon of water. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 4 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 6-8 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 4 ounces per gallon of water before disinfection.

SANITIZATION

(Continued from left panel)

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment in food processing plants, first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 4 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use Lemonene at a rate of 6-8 ounces per gallon to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize cleaned surface with a rinse solution containing 4 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water. Those surfaces which will contact food must be rinsed with water of drinking quality before reuse.

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush with a solution containing 4 ounces of Lemonene per gallon of water.

Lemonene is an effective antibacterial cleaner designed for use in household, industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, Lemonene will disinfect hard surfaces, such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, food storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general antibacterial-antifungal detergent in homes, schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms, food processing plants and in other places where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired.
