DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL DOSE: 1 gallon of this algacide to 50,000 gallons of water. Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or reappear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add at 35 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If make up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of this algacide for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make up water added per week. When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of this algacide to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

FISH AND/OR WILDLIFE PRECAUTIONS: This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Apply this product only as specified on this label. When this algacide is used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of *Chlorella Pyrenoidosa* (green), *Phormidium Inundatum* (black algae), *Phormidium retzii* (Square D algae), *Lyngbya versicolor* (blue green) and other swimming pool algae. This algacide may be used to sanitize pool areas such as walkways, diving boards, ladder rails and walls and floors in dressing areas. Prepare a sanitizing solution by mixing 1 ounce of this algacide with 4 gallons of water. Apply with mop, cloth or sponge to those previously cleaned areas to be sanitized.

This algacide is effective against *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot, at a dilution of 1 1/2 ounces per gallon on water. This algacide is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners, or premixed with other water treating chemicals. This algacide works best when added by itself directly to pool water. This algacide at use is non corrosive to inanimate surfaces.
