

## POOL-CIDE

### COMPOSITION

#### Active ingredients:

### APPLICATIONS

POOL-CIDE is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using POOL-CIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 75 to 115 fl. oz. of POOL-CIDE per 10,000 gal. of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 41 to 75 fl. oz. of POOL-CIDE per 10,000 gal. of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 13.5 to 27 fl. oz. of POOL-CIDE per 10,000 gal. of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

Uniform distribution of POOL-CIDE throughout the water in the pool is necessary for maximum effectiveness.

POOL-CIDE is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. POOL-CIDE can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix POOL-CIDE with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If eye irritation persists get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place away from water supplies.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
