

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is a liquid non-selective, general herbicide which is designed to be used where control of all vegetation is desired. It produces rapid kill of all succulent vegetation. Translocation and root absorption produce extensive root kill of weeds and provides long term control. For easy application and better penetration dilute one gallon of concentrate to 10 gallons of water and apply as directed below. Sufficient moisture from rainfall or artificial means is necessary after treatment to carry the chemical into the roots of the weeds. This product is recommended for non-crop areas such as RAILROADS, HIGHWAYS, PIPELINES, TANK FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, FENCE ROWS and PARKING LOTS. This concentrate can be sprayed or sprinkled on. If sprayed, direct the spray to the base of the weeds and adjust for coarse spray to prevent blowing. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes or do not use equipment for other purposes. Do not reuse this container for other purposes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

ANNUAL WEEDS AND GRASSES: Such as Crabgrass, Foxtail, Ryegrass, Wild Oats, Bromegrass, Lambsquarters, and similar weeds. Use 5 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 750 square feet (200 sq. ft. per acre).

PERENNIAL WEEDS AND GRASSES: Such as Smooth Brome, Quackgrass, Bluegrass, Purple Top, Dandelion, Goldenrod, Wild Carrot and similar weeds. Use 5 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 400 sq. ft. (450 to 500 gal. per acre).

HARD TO KILL PERENNIALS: Such as Johnsongrass, Bermudagrass, Dallisgrass, Nutgrass, Sp. Grass, Dogbane, Hairytail, Buckhorn, and similar weeds. Use 5 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 175 sq. ft. (100 to 120 gal. per acre). Use higher levels of dilution for absorption.

RETREATMENT: Apply 5 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 750 sq. ft. when Annual Weeds and Grasses reappear.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This concentrate after mixing in water, is non-volatile, non-flammable, and non-corrosive to metals except aluminum. Do not use with aluminum spray nozzles.

This concentrate is an effective general herbicide for use on the upland areas for control of brush, mainly annual and perennial weeds and is particularly useful for control of perennial grasses. It is a water soluble liquid to be mixed in water and applied as a spray. This concentrate may be applied undiluted for basal (soil) treatment of brush. Effects are slow to appear and may not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zone of the weeds by moisture. The degree of control and duration of effects will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions.

IMPORTANT—Injury to or loss of desirable trees or other plants may result from failure to observe the following: Do not apply, or drain or flush equipment on or near desirable trees or other plants or on areas where their roots may extend, or in locations where the chemical may be washed or moved into contact with their roots. Do not use on lawns, walks, driveways, tennis courts, or similar areas. Prevent drift of spray to desirable plants. Do not contaminate domestic waters. Keep from contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides and acids. Thoroughly clean all traces of this concentrate from application equipment immediately after use. Flush tank, pump, hoses and boom with several changes of water after removing nozzle tips and screens (Clean these parts separately).

Do not reuse container; crush and bury when empty.
