The product labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Under the heading, Hard To Kill Perennial, revise the following statement to read as follows:

Retreatment is prohibited when 10 gallon application is applied to 400 square feet.

2. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS: Do not allow this product to contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Not to be used in any recreational areas or in or around homes.

This concentrate after mixing in water, is non-volatile, non-flammable, and non-corrosive to metals except aluminum. Do not use with aluminum spray nozzles. This concentrate is an effective general herbicide for use on non-cropland areas for control of brush and many annual and perennial weeds, and is particularly useful for control of perennial grasses. It is a water soluble liquid to be mixed in water and applied as a spray; this concentrate may also be applied undiluted for basal (soil) treatment of brush. Effects are slow to appear and may not become apparent until this product has been carried into the root zone of the weeds by moisture. The degree of control and duration of effects will vary with the amount of product applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions.

IMPORTANT: Injury to or loss of desirable trees or other plants may result from failure to observe the following: Do not apply, or drain or flush equipment on or near desirable trees or other plants or on areas where their roots may extend or in locations where the product may be washed or moved onto contact with their roots. Do not use on lawns, walks, driveways, tennis courts, or similar areas. Prevent drifts of spray to desirable plants. Do not contaminate domestic waters. Keep from contact with fertilizer, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Thoroughly clean all traces of this concentrate from application equipment immediately after use. Flush tank, pump, hoses, and boom with several changes of water after removing tips and screens (clean these parts separately).

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Do not get on skin or clothing. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants in non-crop and non-timber areas only. Not for use on crops, timber, or other plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. This product is a liquid non-selective general herbicide which is designed to be used where control of all vegetation is desired. It produces rapid top kill of all succulent vegetation. Translocation and root absorption produce extensive root kill of weeds and provides long term control. Sufficient moisture from rainfall or artificial means is necessary after treatment to carry the product into the root of the weeds. This product is recommended for non-crop areas such as RAILROADS, HIGHWAYS, PIPELINES, TANKS FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, FENCE ROWS and PARKING LOTS. This concentrate can be sprayed or sprinkled on. If sprayed, direct the spray to the soil at the base of the weeds and adjust for coarse spray to prevent drifting. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes or do not use same equipment for other purposes. Do not reuse this container for other purposes.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: For easy application and better penetration, dilute one gallon of concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply as directed below.

ANNUAL WEEDS AND GRASSES: Such as Crabgrass, Foxtail, Ryegrass, Wild Oats, Ragweed, Broomgrass, Lambsquarter, and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 750 square feet (580 gal./acre).

PERENNIAL WEEDS AND GRASSES: Such as Smooth Brome, Quackgrass, Bluegrass, Purple-Top, Dandelion, Goldenrod, Wild Carrot and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 400 square feet (1,089 gal./acre).

HARD TO KILL PERENNIAL: Such as Johnson Grass, Bermuda Grass, Dallisgrass, Nutgrass, Saltgrass, Dogbane, Horsetail, Bracken Fern and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 400 square feet (1,089 gal./acre). Use higher levels of dosage on absorptive soils. Retreatment is prohibited when 10 gallon application is applied.
