However, after swabbing the entire surface areas especially under rim, add a statement that reads "Let stand for at least 10 minutes, then flush."

Also, delete the statement "For commercial and industrial use . . . persons."

If these conditions are not complied with the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply this product undiluted to non-porous surfaces such as latrine, bedframes with a cloth, mop, wet surface. For heavily soiled surfaces, use a fresh solution daily or weekly. Toilet Bowl: Remove water. Remove excessive water from surface. Pour 1-2 ounces on application surface area especially under rim. DISINFECTION, DEODORIZATION: Apply to porous surfaces treated surface is for schools, industry and other places. 1/2 inch from surface to be disinfected.
