ONE STEP GERMICIDAL DETERGENT AND DEODORANT

A one step germicidal detergent and deodorant effective in hard water up to 400 ppm hard water. Recommended for use in hospitals, nursing homes, schools, and colleges, veterinary clinics, animal life science laboratories and meat and poultry establishments.

Virucidal against Influenza A Virus, Herpes simplex type I, Herpes simplex type II, Varicella, Rubella, Adenovirus type 4 according to the virucidal quantification, modified in the presence of 400 ppm hard water plus 5% organic serum at a 1:128 dilution (1 ounce per gallon of water).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTING:

For use on hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, metal surfaces, porcelain, and plastic surfaces. Remove gross dirt and heavy soil deposits then thoroughly wet surfaces as recommended and required. Use 1 ounce per gallon of water for disinfection. Contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. Can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as spraying or soaking. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use. Rinsing is not necessary unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

For use in meat and poultry plants as a general cleaning agent on all surfaces, or for use with steam or mechanical cleaning device in all departments. Before use of this compound, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. After use of this compound, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water 1 oz per gallon of water.

STATEMENT OF FIRST AID TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.

NOT TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CORROSIVE: Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. To protect eyes, wear goggles or face shield and to protect skin, wear rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Harmful if swallowed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or empty container is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

FIBER DRUMS WITH LINERS

Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into a collection equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

METAL CONTAINERS

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

GENERAL

Consult, federal, state, or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited incineration.

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
