DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner not intended.

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTING:

For use on hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, metal, etc. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits then thoroughly wet with water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application or cloth as well as spraying or soaking. The recommended use is for disinfecting. Rinsing is not necessary unless floors are to be waxed. For use in meat and poultry plants as a general cleaning agent. mechanical cleaning device in all departments. Before use of the materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. 1 oz. per gallon.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. If available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.

GENERAL: Consult, federal, state, or local disposal authorities for limited open burning.

A concentrated, multi-purpose germicidal detergent and deodorant effective in hard waters up to 400 ppm hard water (calculated as CaCO₃) plus 5% organic serum. Disinfects, cleans, and deodorizes in one labor saving step. Recommended for use in hospitals, nursing homes, schools and colleges, veterinary clinics, animal life science laboratories and meat and poultry establishments, equine farms, tack shops, pet shops, airports, kennels, hotels and motels, poultry and turkey farms, dairy farms, and hog farms, breeding and grooming establishments.

Bactericidal @1:128 dilution (1 ounce per gallon of water) against the following organisms according to the current AOAC. Use dilution test method, modified in the presence of 400 ppm synthetic hard water (calculated as CaCO₃) plus 5% organic serum. *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Enterobacter cloacae*, *Streptococcus pyogenes*, *Streptococcus faecalis*, *Enterobacter aerogenes*, *Salmonella typhimurium*, *Klebsiella pneumoniae*, *Proteus vulgaris*, *Serratia marcescens*, *Shigella flexneri*, *Shigella sonnei*, *Salmonella typhi*, *Proteus mirabilis*, *Fusobacterium necrophorum*, *E. coli*, *Staphylococcus aureus* (antibiotic resistant), *Streptococcus faecalis* (antibiotic resistant), *E. coli* (antibiotic resistant), *Klebsiella pneumoniae* (antibiotic resistant), *Staphylococcus epidermidis* (antibiotic resistant), *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* (antibiotic resistant), Canine Parvovirus, Canine distemper virus, Rabies virus, Feline leukemia virus, Feline picornavirus, Porcine parvovirus, Influenza A/Hong Kong, Herpes simplex type 1, Herpes simplex type 2, Vaccinia, Rubella, Adenovirus type 4, Pseudorabies virus, Infectious bronchitis virus (Avian IBV).

Fungicidal against *Trichophyton interdigitale* and *Candida albicans* according to the AOAC Fungicidal Test, modified in the presence of 400 ppm hard water (calculated as CaCO₃) plus 5% organic serum @1:128 dilution.

*Virucidal against the following viruses according to the virucidal qualification, modified in the presence of 400 ppm hard water plus 5% organic serum @1:128 dilution. (1 oz. per gal. of water)*Kills HIV-1 (AIDS virus) on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood/body fluids in healthcare settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (ASSOCIATED WITH AIDS).

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS) OF SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS.

Personal Protection: Disposable latex or vinyl gloves, gowns, face masks, or eye coverings as appropriate, must be worn during all cleaning of body fluids, blood, and decontamination procedures.

Cleaning Procedures: Blood and body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of disinfectant.

Contact Time: Effective against HIV-1 (AIDS virus) on hard non-porous surfaces in the presence of a moderate amount of organic soil (5% blood serum) when used at a 1:128 dilution (providing 600 ppm of active quaternary) on 400 ppm CaCO₃ hard water for a contact time of 4 minutes at room temperature (20-25° C). Use a ten (10) minute contact time for disinfection against all other bacteria, fungi, and viruses claimed (listed on labeling).

Disposal of Infectious Materials: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to federal, state, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.
