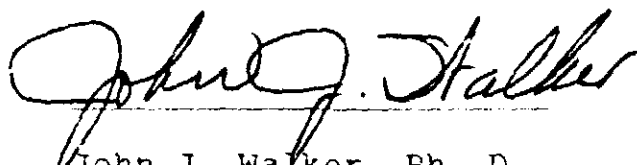

*Kills HIV-1 (AIDS virus) on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood/body fluids in healthcare settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surface/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for the transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (ASSOCIATED WITH AIDS).

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS) ON SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS.

Personal Protection: Disposable latex or vinyl gloves, gowns, face mask, or eye coverings as appropriate, must be worn when cleaning up body fluids, blood, and other potentially infectious materials.

Cleaning Procedure: All body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of disinfectant.

Contact Time: Effective against HIV-1 (AIDS virus) on hard non-porous surfaces in the presence of a moderate amount of organic soil (5% blood serum) when used at a 1:64 dilution (providing 600 ppm of active quaternary) on 400 ppm CaCO₃ hard water for a contact time of 4 minutes at room temperature (20-25°C). Use a ten (10) minute contact time for disinfection against all other bacteria, fungi, and viruses claimed (listed on labeling).

Disposal of Infectious Materials: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to federal, state, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.
