DIRECTIONS

Debuture: To control early and late Blights, use 4 to 6 tablespoonfuls Bordeaux Mixture to i gallon water or 4 to 6 lbs. to 50 gal. water. Spray every 10 to 14 days after plants come up until just before harvest.

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Celery and Tematoes: To control early and late Hight, Leaf Spot use 4 to 5 tablespoonfuls to 1 gal. water or 4 to 5 lbs. to 50 gal. water, spraying or dusting plants in plant bed and at 10 day intervals in the field.

Flewers: To control Leaf Spot use 3 tablespherifuls to 1 galion of water or 3 lbs. to 50 gal, water and apply early in the season and repeat at 10 to 14 days intervals prior to blooming.

Vines and Shrubs: To control Leaf Spot use 2 tablespoonfuls to 1 gal. water or 2 lbs. to 50 gal, water by applying spray 3 times at weekly intervals when new growth appears in the spring.

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BORDEAUX MIXTURE

Active Ingredients:

Copper, expressed as metallic (in the form of Bordeaux Mixture) 12.50% Inert Ingredients 87.50%

Apple and Pear: Delayed Dormant to control Scab, use 4 tablespoonfuls to 1 gallon or 4 pounds Bordeaux to 50 gallons oil spray.

Pre-Blossom Spray. One or two sprays to control Scab. Use 4 tablespoonfuls to one gallon or 4 pounds to 50 gallons of water.

Late Summer Sprays to control Scab, Blotch, Bitter Rot, Frog Eye, use 4 pounds Bordeaux Mixture to 50 gallons of water or with Summer Oil. It may be advisable to add 4 pounds of Hydrated Lime.

Peaches and Plums: A Dormant Spray to control Leaf Curl, San Jose Scale, Red Mite, use 3 tablespoonfuls to 1 gallon or 3 pounds to 50 gallon oil spray.

Melons: To control Anthracnose, Scab, Leaf Spot, use 3 tablespoonfuls to 1 gallon or 3 lbs. to 50 gal. of water. Spray as soon as plants appear and repeat at 5 day intervals during vining.

Grapes: To control Downy Mildew, Black Rot, use 3 to 4 tablespoonfuls of Bordeaux Mixture to 1 gallon or 4 lbs. to 50 gal water. Spray when shoots are 8 to 10 inches long, before blossom buds open, again after blossoms fall and again 10 to 14 days later.

Cherries: To control Leaf Spot, use 3 tablespoonfuls of Bordeaux Mixture to 1 gallon of water or 3 lbs. to 50 gal, water. On Sweet Cherries it is advisable to add 4 lbs. Hydated Lime. Spray as soon as the petals fall and again one week later, plus two additional preharvest applications at 10-14 day intervals and two applications after fruit is harvested at 14 day intervals.
