DIRECTIONS

PHALTAN Wettable Powder is a wettable fungicide formulation. Use 1 level tablespoonful per gallon of water (1 pound per 100 gallons water).

ROSES: Black Spot, Powdery Mildew—Make first application when young leaves first appear. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals or as necessary throughout the season. To improve wetting for mildew control, combine with Patterson's Spreader-Sticker.

CHRYSANTHEMUMS: Septoria Leaf Spot—Start treatments immediately after planting, repeating at 7 to 10 day intervals or as necessary throughout season.

GLADIOLUS CORMS: Rot (preplanting)—Use 10 tablespoonfuls per gallon. Soak bulbs in diluted mixture 20 to 30 minutes, drain and plant. Keep mixture stirred.

CARNATIONS: Rust, Alternaria—Begin applications 2 weeks after planting, and continue biweekly applications for 3 to 4 applications.

ZINNIAS, MARIGOLDS: Alternaria, Leafspot; **CHRYSANTHEMUMS, ASTERS, PHLOX:** Powdery Mildew (Erysiphe); **SNAPDRAGON:** Anthracnose, Powdery Mildew—Treat at least weekly during periods of rapid new growth and severe infections and twice weekly during periods of continuous rains or high humidity.

POINSETTIA (greenhouse): Root Rot (pythium)—Use 1 pt. diluted solution per 8 inch pan. Use Spreader-Sticker. Make first application at time of panning. Repeat in 10 days.

AZALEAS (cuttings): Damp-off (Cylindrocium)—1 to 2 lbs. per 100 gallons. Allow to soak for 15 to 30 minutes before placing in rooting media.

CHERRY (sour): Leaf Spot—Post harvest use only. Make thorough, uniform coverage as soon as harvest is completed. Repeat as necessary, but do not apply to sour cherry before harvest. Phaltan may cause injury to foliage of sweet cherry.

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation of dust or spray mist. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Do not apply to food crops.

COMPATIBILITY: PATTERSON'S PHALTAN WETTABLE POWDER may be combined with most commonly used insecticides, adjuvants and fungicides with the exception of strongly alkaline materials. Do not use in combination with or closely following oil sprays.
