**BROADLEAF WEEDS CONTROLLED:** Buckhorn, Burdock, Chicory, Dandelion, Frenchweed, Ground Ivy, Healall, Lambsquarter, Mallow, Morning Glory, Pigweed, Plantain, Poison Ivy, Poison Oak, and Sow Thistle.

**HARD TO KILL BROADLEAF WEEDS CONTROLLED:** Common Chickweed, Mouse ear Chickweed, Bur Clover, White Clover, Creeping Charlie (ground ivy), Curly Dock, Dog Fennel, Henbit, Knawel, Knotweed, Mustard, Oxalis, Peppergrass, Purslane, Red Sorrel, Sheep Sorrel, Wood Sorrel, Spotted Spurge, Yarrow.

**FOR LAWNS, FAIRWAYS and other ORNAMENTAL TURF**

**WHEN TO USE:** For best results apply on lawns in the spring or early summer when weeds are young and actively growing. Late summer or early fall is also recommended to control weeds that have developed from seeds during the summer.

For Best Results Apply When Grass Is Damp from Dew, Rain or Watering

**HOW TO APPLY:** The contents of this bag covers 5,000 sq. ft. Apply evenly at the rate of about 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (for example 10 ft. x 100 ft. = 1,000 sq. ft.) See chart below for suggested spreader settings. Do NOT mow grass for two days before and after application. DO NOT USE on newly seeded lawns until several mowings have been made. Reseeding should be delayed 3 weeks after application.

Do not use on Centipede Grass, St. Augustine Grass, or Dichondra, nor on lawns or turf where desirable bermgrass or clovers are present. Do not allow dust to come in contact with shrubs, flowers, trees, vegetables or other valuable plants. Avoid application to areas under the branches or drip line of trees and shrubs.
