DANGER-POISON-PRECAUTIONS

POISONOUS IF SWALLGWED

This product can kill you if swallowed even in small amounts: spray mist or dust may be fatal if swallowed.

POISONOUS BY SKIN CONTACT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COTTON: To control overwintering Boll Weevil, Thrips, Aprilds, Fleahoppers and certain Mites, use 1 gt in amount of water to cover 1 acre.

FRUITED STAGE. To control Bon Weevil, Lealworm, Fall Armyworm, use 1 qt. 2 qts in the

For boil weevil during the early season, apply at the 2 to 4 leaf stage or at first squaring, if weevils are present, and make 3 to 4 applications at weekly intervals as necessary, during mid and late season. apply when 10 percent of squares or bolis are punctured and repeat 4 to 5 day intervals as necess. ary. For pollworm, apply when eggs and 3 to 4 small bollworm larvae are found per 100 but term. inals, sind repeat at weekly intervals as necessary, late season control of bollworm may require applic. ations to be repeated at 4 - to 5 day intervals.

If we contain applied, apply when applies are present in the buds and on the leaves of seedling cotton, or when honey dow develops on older cotton, repeat as needed.

For thrips and fleahoppers, apply at the 2 - to 4 leaf stage and make 2 to 3 applications at weekly


