DIRECTIONS

SOD WEBWORM CONTROL is a granular insecticide for use on lawns and areas of turf. It is effective against Sod Webworms and other larvae of the webworm family. May eggs are deposited in the soil and hatch in May. By early June the larvae are in the soil and are active. The webworm population of later broods and their damage to turf is not known.

WHEN TO APPLY: New Sod Webworms may appear in lawns from May through August. For this reason, it is suggested that applications be made one to three weeks apart starting application in May. Apply in the early morning or late in the day when worms are active.

HOW TO APPLY: Turf should be free of debris and free of high grass. Cut grass insects. Rake the area and remove the debris to expose the soil. Water the lawn and cut to a height of 2 1/2 inches. Catch the grass clippings if possible. Apply one bag Patterson Sod Webworm Control to treat 5,000 sq. ft. Make sure of the square footage. Use a broadcast spreader such as Patterson's Greenfields or Scotts. After application, water the lawn.

Walking speed, evenness of lawn and spreader condition may necessitate a slight variation in setting for application.
