DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read all the directions first. Remove cap. Hold can upright with nozzle opening away from you. Keep fingers out of stream, hold at least a foot away from foliage to prevent freezing. If you wet the foliage, you are too close. Do not over-spray. Keep the nozzle sweeping. Do not use when foliage is wet. Do not spray in extreme mid-day temperature or make application to plants that lack water. Make repeat applications weekly. Kills on contact lace bugs, mealy bugs, black gnats, ants, white flies and leafhoppers as well as suppresses mites that may be present. Direct spray contact may be used on African violets, begonias, ivy, ferns, gloxinia, fushia and most tropical green plants. If foliage is very tender, spray one leaf and check 24 hours to see if burn results. ~~If not treat plant as needed.~~
