PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER KEEP OUT OR REACH OF CHILDREN.

Corrosive. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling concentrate. If splashed in eyes, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For further treatment, get medical attention.

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid exposure. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. In case of contact, wash with soap and water. In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer milk or water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or 15 ml.) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children. Always wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine sulphate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply where run-off is likely.

WHERE TO USE — This product may be used on plants, flowers, shrubs, evergreens and deciduous trees. Royal Purple Smoke trees (Cotinus Sp.) or necessary spray one or two branchlets and observe treatment. Do not use on plants used for food.

WHEN TO USE — Spray when insects or insects are anticipated. Repeat as needed for control.

INSECTS CONTROLLED — This product provides protection from insect attack. The spray kills insects on contact and the active ingredient is absorbed by the plant's system of action.

Use a hose for shrubbery, a Gilmore sprayer or a suitable sprayer as indicated above. For best coverage on waxy surfaces, use a suitable approved Spreader Sticker in the spray.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL

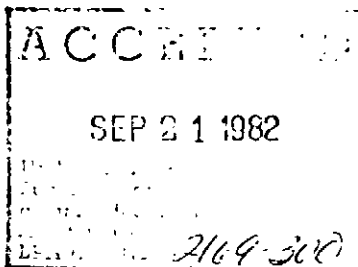

INSECT CONTROL ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS
WHERE TO USE — This product may be used out-of-doors on ornamental plants, flowers, shrubs, evergreens and deciduous trees. Do not use on Royal Purple Smoke trees, Cotinus, Sp. or on Carnations or Zinnias. If necessary, spray one or two branchlets and observe for 4 to 5 days before overall treatment. Do not use on plants used for food or forage.

WHEN TO USE — Spray when insects or their damage is first seen or anticipated. Repeat as needed for control.

INSECTS CONTROLLED — This product provides plants with a 2 way protection from insect attack. The spray kills insects on contact and in addition the spray is absorbed by the plant and acts sucking insects by systemic action.

Use a hose-end type sprayer designed for shrubbery, a Gilmore sprayer or a suitable pressure sprayer and dilute as indicated above. For best coverage on waxy or hard-to-wet plants use a suitable approved Spreader Sticker in the spray solution.
