

CORN (Suset) -- Insects: Cutworms, Flea Beetles.

Diseases: Helminthosporium Leaf Blight, Puccinia Rust.
For Cutworms dust around the base of seedling plants up until plants are 112 to 2 feet high.

LETTUCE, DANDELION, ESCAROLE, BALSETY -- Insects: Armyworm, Flea Beatles, Harlequin Bug, Imported
Cabbageworm, Leafhoppers, Stink Bugs, Tarnished Plant Bug.

Disease: Downy Mildew.

(3) days on Head Lettuce, (14) days on Leaf Lettuce and others listed above.

TOMATOES, PRPPERS, EGGPLANT -- Insects: Cutworms, European Com Borer, Fall Armyworm, Flee Bestles, Lace Bugs, Lesihospers, Stink Bugs, Tarnished Plant Bug, Tomato Fruitworm-Hornworm-and

Disasses: Peppers (Anthracnose Ripe Rot and Phytophthora) Eggplant (Anthracnose) Tomatoes (Early and Late Blight, Anthracnose, Cledosponium Gray Mold, Septoria Leaf Spot and Stemphylium.

Do not apply within (5) days of hervest.
