



**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mericide M is used to control bacteria in water for use in circulating commercial and industrial water cooling systems. For use in cooling systems, it has been found to be effective in controlling slime and other deposits. An initial concentration of 1.7 to 10.2 mg per gallon of **Mericide M** per 1000 gallons of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosages are not required. Subsequent concentrations of 1.7 to 10.2 mg per gallon of **Mericide M** per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 30 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bio-film growth, severity of the microbiological problem, and other factors. Results made in the form of water cooling systems.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL Pesticide spray, mixture, or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticide collection. Do not discharge into water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL Containers under 30 gallon capacity must not be reused but should be triple rinsed and disposed of in an incinerator or landfill approved for insecticide containers or buried in a safe place. Containers over 30 gallon capacity should be triple rinsed and offered for reconditioning or triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill, or buried in a safe place.
