The amendment application for name change and label changes referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, are acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Expand the Environmental Hazard statement to read as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.



Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Harmful if inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not inhale vapor or spray mist. Wear protective clothing, rubber gloves and goggles or face shield. Wash with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

First Aid:

External: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes.

Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

Internal: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Immediately call a physician or Poison Control Center. **Note to Physician:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

Inhalation: Remove immediately to fresh air. If not breathing, apply artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Get medical attention immediately.

Environmental Hazards

Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Nopoclide 18 is best added by slug method to the troubled areas of paper mills. It is used in a dosage range of 0.25 to 1.0 lbs. (3.7 - 14.8 fluid ounces) per ton of dry pulp for the control of gram negative and gram positive bacteria and various types of molds and yeasts which contribute to slime problems encountered in paper mill systems. Intermittent or continuous feeding to the white water, beaters, hydropulpers, etc. can also be used. Technical assistance regarding specific site problems is available from our representative.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage

Store tightly covered in a cool, dry, ventilated area away from heat. Do not allow product to freeze.

Pesticide Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning (for plastic containers incinerate) or puncture and dispose of in an approved sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
