Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger

Causes severe burns of eyes. Eye contact may cause loss of vision. May burn the skin. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed.

Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Chemical worker's goggles must be worn when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling.

First Aid

In case of eye contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

In case of skin contact, immediately wash skin with soap and plenty of water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If swallowed, immediately induce vomiting by giving two glasses of water and sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit is clear. Call a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

Note: Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the EPA.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Note: Add Nopocide 22 separately to the system. Do not mix it with other additives, in order to avoid decomposition of Nopocide 22 due to the high pH of many additive formulations.

Paper Mills

For the control of bacterial, fungal and yeast growths in pulp, paper and paperboard mills, add Nopocide 22 at the rate of 0.15-0.50 lb./ton of pulp or paper (dry basis). Addition may be continuous or intermittent, depending upon the type of system and severity of contamination. It should be made with a metering pump at a location that will insure uniform distribution of Nopocide 22 in the mass of fiber and water, such as the beaters, jordan inlet or discharge, broke chutes, furnish chests, save-alls and white-water tanks.
