## FOR HOSPITAL USE

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To clean and disinfect floors walls and furniture, wash with solution of one (1) ounce Legphene per gallon of water. For porous or heavily contaminated surfaces, use two (2) ounces Legphene per gallon of water. Surfaces to be disinfected must be thoroughly wetted and gross filth removed.

**Active Ingredients:** Isopropanol 9.9%, potassium dodecyl benzene sulfonate 5.7%, potassium ortho benzyl-para-chlorophenate 4.0%, potassium para-tertiary amylphenate 3.8%, potassium ortho phenylphenate 2.4%, tetra-sodium ethylene diamine tetraacetate 1.5%, essential oils 0.2% 27.5%

**Inert Ingredients:** Water, hexylene glycol sodium sulfite 72.5%

### DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
