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The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated March 27, 1998 agrees with the label, it is filled out correctly and is acceptable.

The Agency is concerned with the use of the product name "Ellimstaph #3. This name implies that the product not only will eliminate staphylococcus wherever it occurs. This is a broad claim that need to be supported. The Agency is in the process of examining its policies on the names of registered pesticide products. In the future efficacy data will likely be required to support broad claims implied in a product name. We suggest that you pursue the development of efficacy data if you are interested in retaining the use of this name and similar names on other products you have registered. Alternatively, you can always amend your label to change the product name.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ELIMSTAPH NO. 3 is intended for institutional and industrial use. To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors and other hard surfaces, use one (1) ounce **ELIMSTAPH NO. 3** per gallon of water. Apply **ELIMSTAPH NO. 3** using a mop, cloth or sponge so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. Allow treated surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes and air dry. Gross filth and heavy soil deposits must be removed prior to cleaning. Change work solution daily or as it becomes visibly dirty. Please see technical brochure for additional information.

***VIRUCIDAL PERFORMANCE**

At 1 oz. per gallon use level, **ELIMSTAPH NO. 3** was evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and 400 ppm hard water for a contact time of 10 minutes at room temperature (20-25 C) against HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS) found on inanimate, hard, non-porous environmental surfaces.

***Kills HIV on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood/body fluids in health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS).**

Contact Time: Leave surface wet for 10 minutes with 1 oz. per gallon use dilution.

Personal Protection: Clean-up should always be done wearing protective latex gloves, gowns, masks and eye protection.
