The inner bag label referred to above submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Put EPA Registration No. 2214-6 on the bag.
 - b. Put the disposal statement "Wrap empty bag and put in trash collection" on the bag.
 - c. Put the "Net Contents" on the bag.
 - d. Have the correct ingredient percentages 89% and 11% rather than 93% and 7%.
 - e. On the left panel of the inner bag label, add the following heading.

Precautionary Statement
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals
DANGER

The cellophane wrapper label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. The ingredient statement should be:

Paraformaldehyde.....89%
INERT INGREDIENTS.....11%


- b. The EPA Registration No. should be on the front, not the side, panel.
- c. The Child Hazard Warning should be above the signal word and Skull & Crossbones. These label elements must be of the correct type size on both labels (inner bag, outer cellophane). See enclosure for type size requirements.
- d. On the right panel of the label add the following heading:

Direction for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use
this product in a manner inconsistent
with the labeling.

- 3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
- 4. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRAsec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
- 5. Stamped copies of the labeling are enclosed for your records.
