The amendment (general label update) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling. (Outer Bag only-Cellophane).

a. Delete the claim to "Damp Rid". Advertising other products on pesticide labels is not permitted. NOTE: This registration number "2214-6" is assigned to only "Di•Gas" and must not be used as an endorsement for other any products that your company markets.

b. Just a reminder that the word: "Poison" must be in red and on a background of contrasting color.

c. Revise "Net Weight" to read: Net Contents.

d. The following form of the ingredient statement is preferred:

~~Inert Ingredients..... %~~

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e. The following precautionary heading:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

should be located heading directly above the signal word: Danger

f. Revise the referral statement: "See inside package for other warnings" to read: "Refer to side panel and inside package for additional precautionary statements".

g. Delete the Word: Caution. (right panel).

h. Revise the heading: Directions to read: Direction for Use.

i. Provide instruction for disposal of this wrapper.

j. Add the statement as outlined in your fax (page 2) which states: "Do not remove or sprinkle contents or inner bag in areas to be protected. Avoid placing inner bag closer than 24" from carpets or rugs as discoloration may result."

2. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling. (Inner Bag only-Unwoven Fabric).

a. Incorporate the statement "Use in unoccupied areas only. Ventilate treated areas before entry." Ref: your fax: item #1 (page 1).

b. Change your company address. Ref: your fax: item #2 (page 1).

c. Revise "Net Wt" to read: Net Contents.

d. Add the following heading to the left pane: Statement of Practical Treatment.

e. Add the heading: Precautionary Statements. Place this heading to appear directly above the subheading: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

f. The statements: "If in eyes" and "If on skin" should be joined with the other "Statements of Practical Treatment" on the left panel.

g. Add the following additional precautionary statements:

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

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h. Just a reminder that the word: "Poison" must be in red and on a background of contrasting color.

i. The decimal points in the ingredient section percentages must be aligned.

j. Align the headings "Active Ingredient" and "Inert Ingredients" to the same left margin.

3. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

4. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

It has been noted that even though the label is stamped acceptable at this time, the most recent Confidential Statement of Formula (dated 05-23-90) will be the official CSF of record. It is understood that the current source of the Active ingredient is a cancelled product however when a new source becomes available, it will be your responsibility to notify the Agency with a new CSF.

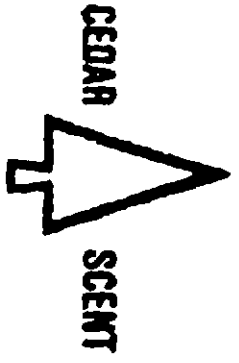
