STORAGE : Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. Keep form freezing.

FEED STORAGE - FARM BUILDINGS - INDUSTRIAL USES:

For SURFACE SPRAYING: Dilute 1 to 9 with water and spray all surfaces where insects crawl, rest or hide. Spray walls, in cracks and crevices, and under equipment. Apply as a coarse wet spray. Do not apply on surfaces where water stains are objectionable.

FOR FOGGING: To kill exposed adults of stored grain insects such as Granary Weevil, Rice Weevil, Cadelle and Angomois Moth employ a fog generator using 1 pint of this product to 40,000 cubic feet. Repeat surface spraying or fog applications as needed.

FLOUR AND GRAIN BEETLES, WEEVILS AND GRAIN MOTHS (Exposed stages):

Before spraying clean processing equipment. Completely remove all accumulations of dust, grain, and other infested food products. Dilute 1 to 9 with water and apply at the rate of 1 gallon per 750 square feet. Thoroughly spray all surfaces where insects may rest or harbor such as cracks and crevices, partitions and under equipment. Repeat as needed.

COCKROACHES - WATERBUGS - ANTS - SILVERFISH - CHEESE MITES:

Dilute 1 to 9 with water and apply at the rate of 1 gallon per 750 square feet of surface. Treat all hiding places, entrances, insect trails, partitions, and around equipment, shelves, cabinets, and containers. Repeat treatments at regular intervals or as necessary.

Use the product as a space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Ventilate before re-occupying.
