FOR USE ON RESIDENTIAL AND OTHER TURF SITES EXCLUDING SOD FARMS.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dusts has settled.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

- OTHER USE PRECAUTIONS -

Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure cotton, beans, cucumbers, grapes, roses, tomatoes, other vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants. Coarse sprays applied at low pressures are less likely to drift. Do not overdose. Do not use equipment used in applying this material to apply insecticides or fungicides to susceptible plants or seeds. Do not use on grass seed crops or on turf containing creeping bentgrasses. Do not use on grass seedlings less than 2 months old. Clovers present in turf may be damaged. Do not use on St. Augustinegrass, dichondra, or carpetgrass.

- GENERAL INFORMATION -

This product may be used for the control of many broadleaf annual and perennial weeds growing in lawns, turf, vacant lots, and fence rows. In general, this product is most effective when weeds are small and growth is active. It may be applied when the temperature ranges from 65°F to 90°F. Results obtained above and below these temperatures will be considerably slower and more erratic. Do not apply if rain is expected within 4 hours. Application may be made with either power or hand type sprayers. Use with water only. Will not mix with oil. Since local weather and growing conditions may vary the action of this product, it should always be used according to recommendations of State Agricultural Extension Service.

LAWNS AND TURF: For control of susceptible or easy to kill weeds in lawns and turf, use 1 tablespoon of this product per gallon of water (1 gallon will cover approximately 1,000 square feet) and apply either as a spot or broadcast spray. For hard to kill or more resistant weeds use 2 tablespoons per gallon of water and apply as necessary for control.

The maximum application rate to turf is 0.7 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

VACANT LOTS AND WASTE AREAS: For controlling broadleaf weeds in these areas use 2 tablespoons of this product per gallon of water and apply to thoroughly wet all weeds. Repeat application every 2 to 3 weeks as necessary to control new growth and any regrowth.
