

To protect animals from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, apply 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair but not to soak the hide. Repeat treatment once or twice daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control bloodsucking lice, apply the spray lightly to infested areas, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per animal. Repeat every two or three weeks as required.

BARNS, MILK ROOMS, DAIRY PLANTS

To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, apply as a fog or fine mist, directing spray toward the ceiling and upper corners, until the area is filled with mist, using about 2 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet or space. For best results, close windows and doors before spraying and keep closed for ten to fifteen minutes. Vacate the area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat application as necessary.

FOG FOR FLYING INSECTS

Use a good compressed air or fog generator to dispense into atmosphere as a fine mist. For house flies, mosquitoes and gnats in food processing establishments, or Indian Meal Moth and Angumois Moth in grain storage or processing plants, use at the rate or 2 to 3 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet (1 gallon per 40,000 cubic feet). Doors, windows and outside ventilation must be closed to contain mist for 20 to 30 minutes. Repeat treatment as needed. Remove animals or pets during operation.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS

Such as roaches, best results are obtained by using coarse mist spray, applying freely. Thoroughly spray all cracks and crevices where the insects could hide, particularly in areas where plumbing is installed.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS

Use the product as a spacespray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

STORED GRAIN

Make a light spray application -- 2 gallons to 1,000 square fect -- directly to the grain surface to control Indian Meal Moth, Angumois Moth and other grain infesting insects that are feeding on or near the surface of the grain. Make one or more applications, or as needed throughout the storage period.
