USES

GARDEN PROTECTOR may be used on beans, cabbage, cauliflower, currants, cole and cucurbit crops and many other vegetables, flowers, vines, and ornamentals. Gives excellent control of a wide variety of insects including bean leaf beetle, Mexican Bean beetle, certain aphids (plant lice), cabbage worms, flea beetles, currant worm, sawfly larvae, spittle bugs, raspberry fruitworm, white fly and asparagus beetles.

GARDEN PROTECTORmay be used with safety when applied as directed on the edible portions of vegetables and fruit. GARDEN PROTECTOR will not injure tender plant foliage. See CAUTION.

GARDEN PROTECTOR may be used effectively against fleas and lice on dogs, cats, chickens and birds. Dust the animal thoroughly. Repeat application when fleas or lice reappear.

DIRECTIONS

AS A DUST — Apply with a dust gun or sift from the shaker top carton. Dust plant thoroughly, covering both upper and lower sides of foliage, covering all insects to be controlled.

AS A SPRAY — Stir four to six tablespoonfuls into a paste with a little, water, then add sufficient water to make one gallon of spray. The mixture should be agitated occasionally to maintain an effective suspension. Spray plants thoroughly covering all insects to be controlled.
