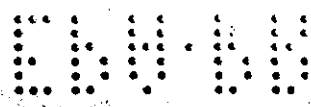

DIRECTIONS

AS A DUST - Apply with a dust gun or sift from the shaker . top carton. Dust plant thoroughly, covering both upper and lower sides of foliage, covering all insects to be controlled.

For Control of Insects on:

- Asparagus: Asparagus beetles
- Beans: Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean leaf beetle
- Cucumbers: Striped cucumber beetle and Squash Vine Borer
- Cabbage & Cauliflower: Cabbage looper, vegetable weevil and Harlequin bug
- Eggplants and Peppers: Flea beetles and pepper maggot
- Potatoes: Colorado potato beetle and flea beetles
- Tomatoes: ~~Colorado potato beetle~~ and flea beetles

Make application at first sign of insects and repeat as necessary. Do not apply closer than one day before harvest. Use at the rate of 25 to 100 pounds per acre. This can treats 200 to 1200 feet of row depending on size of plants and degree of infestation.

GARDEN PROTECTOR may be used effectively against fleas on dogs and cats. Dust sleeping quarters and replace with fresh bedding. Rub dust into hair or fur. Repeat as needed for control.

CAUTION: Dust may cause irritation of nose and throat. Do not breathe dust. Do not apply to crops within one day of harvest. Harmful if taken internally.

This product toxic to fish. Do not allow to drift into any body of water. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds.
