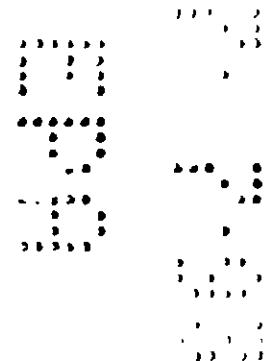

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF ON SKIN: Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. If irritation develops, get medical attention.

HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY

- GENERAL -

Be sure soil is moist and lawn healthy before treating. During droughts water grass well several days in advance and restore turf to healthy green color with fertilizer before treating.

This product is a selective crabgrass killer at recommended rates of application in the presence of Kentucky bluegrass, Merion bluegrass, and Zoysiagrass. Under ideal weather and turf conditions, such as cool days and moist turf, it is also selective in the presence of sensitive grasses, such as fescues and bents. Discoloration may occur in fescues and bentgrass areas, hence only the "Young Crabgrass" dosage is recommended when these grasses predominate. This will require a number of treatments if spraying is delayed until crabgrass is mature in these areas. Will injure St. Augustinegrass, bahiagrass, carpetgrass and centipede grass.

USE PRECAUTIONS

DO NOT USE ON NEWLY SEEDED LAWNS UNTIL AFTER THE THIRD MOWING

DO NOT USE ON ST. AUGUSTINEGRASS, CENTIPEDEGRASS, or BAHIAGRASS.

DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN OR PETS ON TREATED AREAS UNTIL AFTER SPRINKLING AND GRASS IS DRY.

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DO NOT USE A HOSE-END SPRAYER.

DO NOT USE HIGH SPRAYER PRESSURE SINCE FINE DROPLETS COULD BE FORMED WHICH MIGHT DRIFT TO NEARBY SENSITIVE PLANTS.

YOUNG CRABGRASS: In early summer when crabgrass is young, mix 1/2 pint of product in 3 gallons of water and apply over 1,000 square feet. Follow with two or more treatments at 7 day intervals. Repeated applications may be necessary.

CRABGRASS (Vigorously Growing): Mix 3/4 pint in 3 gallons of water and apply over 1,000 square feet. Follow with more treatments at 7 day intervals.

LAWNS COMPLETELY OVERRUN WITH CRABGRASS AND SEEDHEADS ARE FIRST VISIBLE: Mix 1/2 pint in 3 gallons of water and apply over 1,000 square feet, using two treatments at 7 day intervals. This application may discolor turfgrasses.
