

DIRECTIONS FOR MIXING — Pour one quart of Toxaphene Back Rubber Solution into a clean 5-gallon pail or can containing 4 gallons of No. 1 or No. 2 fuel oil or diesel fuel oil. Mix by stirring thoroughly. The diluted solution when mixed as directed contains 5 per cent toxaphene.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — Pour mixed solution into oil reservoir or apply to burlap or canvas covering until saturated. Replenish unit with suitable amounts of the mixed solution as necessary. Regular exposure of the animals for about 10 weeks is usually necessary for satisfactory results against lice.

CAUTION — Be sure oil is free of dirt or other sediment when using mechanically operated equipment. Do not mix Back Rubber Solution with used motor oil, crankcase drainings, or grease. Check mechanical equipment before filling to be sure it is operating properly. Reservoirs should be clean; faulty or dirty valves and mechanisms should be cleaned or replaced.
