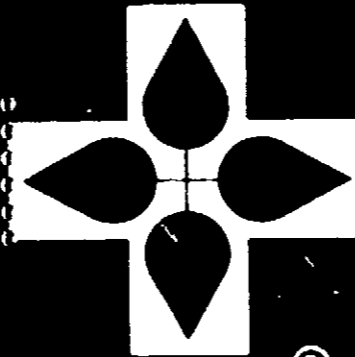

tie with water to 12 or 15 gallon level. Apply to the pre-measured area of 1,000 square feet. Spray until bottle is empty. Repeat for each 1,000 square feet of lawn.

**Pressure Sprayer:** Mix 4 ounces with each 2 gallons of water and spray on 1,000 square feet. Sprinkle area to get chemical to soil level.

**When to Use:** Make two applications, the first near April 15th, and second June 1. Spray in early evening, as worms feed at this time. In late summer, if lawn has been attacked and turf begins to die, rake the thatch from the

appear around the first of June and then again in late August. Spray ground around trees to kill larvae.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Sod Webworm Spray is offered especially for the control of the Lawn Sod Webworms found in Blue Grass Turf. Read directions carefully before using. Also controls certain other pests found on ornamental plants.

**LAWN AND TURF PESTS**      **RATE OF DILUTION AND COMMENTS HOW TO USE:**

**SOD WEBWORM (Blue Grass Lawns)** For each 1,000 square feet of lawn, mix as follows:

Hose-end Lawn Sprayers: Add 4 ounces concentrate to sprayer bottle. Fill bot-

surface of the lawn and use 6 ounces per 1,000 square feet. Thoroughly water lawn 3 to 4 days after treatment. Plan on using a good lawn fertilizer to rejuvenate turf.

**CHIGGERS and TICKS**

Mix 4 tbsp. to 4½ pints water (2 qt. in 10 gallons). Spray to thoroughly cover all grass and weed foliage where insects hide. If possible, make application 6 to 12 hours before rain. Repeat as needed.

**BOXELDER BUGS**

Mix 2 qts. to 5 gallons water (4 tbsp. per 1½ pint). Spray or paint on foundations, porches, steps, window and door frames and places where insects may enter house. Treat boxelder trees and also spray insects directly. Repeat as needed for control.

Mix 2 qts. in 50 gallons water (4 tbsp. in 1½ gallons). Apply in spring when insects are first seen. Cover all new growth and leaves. Use high pressure sprayer.

**CATALPA WORMS on Catalpa**

Mix 2 qts. in 50 gallons of water (4 tbsp. in 1½ gallons) and thoroughly spray foliage and insects. Worms may appear around the first of June.
