

DIRECTIONS

SWIMMING POOL MAINTENANCE

1. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon FBI Algicide for each 10,000 gallons of water to control growth of green algae species.
2. When growth has ceased and existing algae have withered, clean the pool, draining and refilling if necessary, then add one gallon FBI Algicide per 10,000 gallons of water.
3. If algae growth is absent, use one to three gallons FBI Algicide for each 10,000 gallons of water.
4. Add one gallon of FBI Algicide per 50,000 gallons of water every five to seven days, as necessary, to maintain between two and five parts per million of active ingredient. See service manual for test kit.

LOCKER ROOM DISINFECTION

Guard against spread of athlete's foot, ^{fungi} by mopping walkways, poolside and locker room floors with solution of FBI Algicide and disinfectant. Use it also to disinfect bathing suits and caps.

1. Clean floors and runways with suitable detergent, then mop with solution containing one ounce FBI Algicide and disinfectant per gallon of water.
2. After washing, immerse suits and caps for ten minutes in solution containing one ounce FBI Algicide and disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse, wring and hang to dry.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use if contents are frozen.

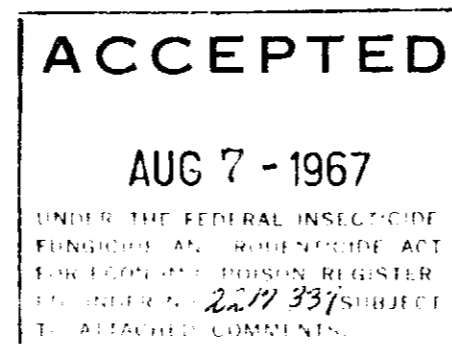
