DIRECTIONS FOR USE

(To be applied by PEST CONTROL OPERATORS ONLY.)

MOSQUITOES, FLIES, GNATS—Dilute 1.8 oz. per gallon of No. 2 Fuel Oil 71 gal. per 70 gal. to make a 1% VAPONA fogging spray. **OUTDOORS**—Apply with fogging machine at rate of 5 to 10 pints of spray per acre around golf courses, bars, open-air drive-in theaters, disposal areas. Repeat as necessary. Do not treat areas where food or food crops are growing. **INDOORS**—Fog at rate of one pint of fogging spray per 1,000 cubic feet for control of flies, mosquitoes, and gnats in warehouses, industrial plants, theaters, and horse stables. Apply when plants are not in operation. Occupants should vacate before indoor treatments and should not reoccupy the premises until it has been ventilated.

CAUTION: Extinguish all pilot lights before fogging for indoor use.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USING

VAPONA 50% Concentrate and the diluted sprays are poisonous. Therefore, precautions must be observed when handling them. They are to be used by or under the supervision of licensed personnel or Pest Control operators only. See directions and warnings below. Store the concentrate in a safe place. Children or animals must not be able to reach or handle the concentrate or sprays. It is recommended that only the amount of diluted sprays be prepared from the concentrate that will be used immediately.

Mix the concentrate outdoors or in a well ventilated room. Wash the outside of the bottle of concentrate in running water before storing away. Do not contaminate lakes or streams. Do not contaminate feed, water or food stuffs.

WARNING DANGER

VAPONA 50% Concentrate is poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed thru skin or eyes. Do not get on skin or eyes or on clothing. Do not breathe fumes. Avoid producing sparks or flames. This material is rapidly absorbed through the skin. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
