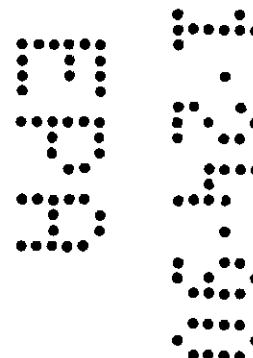

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin or eyes. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing. Do not breathe fumes. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Launder contaminated clothing before re-use.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration as indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminate clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

WARNING SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pinpoint pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product is an organic phosphate which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Solvent presents aspiration hazards. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

TO BE APPLIED BY PEST CONTROL OPERATORS ONLY.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. To prevent cross-contamination, keep separated from other pesticides, fertilizers, seeds, food and feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. MOSQUITOES, FLIES, GNATS -- Dilute 1.8 oz. per gallon of No. 2 Fuel Oil (1 gal. per 70 gal.) to make a 1% VAPONA Fogging Spray.

OUTDOORS -- Apply with fogging machine at rate of 5 to 10 pints of spray per acre around golf courses, parks, open-air drive-in theaters, disposal areas. Repeat as necessary. Do not treat areas where food or food crops are growing.

INDOORS -- Fog at rate of one pint of fogging spray per 8,000 cubic feet for control of flies, mosquitoes, and gnats in warehouses, industrial plants, theaters, and horse stables. Apply when plants are not in operation. Occupants should vacate before indoor treatments and should not reoccupy the premises until it has been ventilated.

NOTE: Extinguish all pilot lights before fogging for mist type sprayers.
