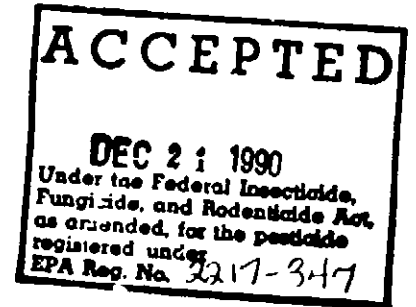

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets.

Use only with adequate ventilation. After using this product indoors, ventilate thoroughly before occupying enclosed spaces. Do not allow contact with treated surface until dusts have settled.

GORDON'S DAIRY AND LIVESTOCK DUST is a combination of two highly effective fly-control chemicals. To prevent the number of horn flies from increasing rapidly on dairy animals begin dusting animals in the spring when flies first appear.

DAIRY ANIMALS (Non-lactating) -- HORN FLIES (on beef cattle also): Use 2 heaping tablespoonfuls (2 oz.) per animal for control of horn flies. Dust on poll, neck, and back of upper sides. Rub in lightly to insure that the material is worked down beneath the hair. If application is made by dust gun, apply against the grain of hair to force material into the hair. Do not repeat applications within 3-week time period. Do not contaminate water troughs. Do not treat calves under 30 days of age. Do not apply during lactation or within 2 weeks of freshening.

BEEF CATTLE -- LICE, TICKS, AND HORN FLIES: For control of lice, ticks, and horn flies make application to all parts of the animal's body. Rub into hair as application is made. Repeat treatment as necessary to control infestation. Repeat at 10 to 14 day intervals. Do not treat calves under 30 days of age.

HOGS -- LICE: Apply for complete coverage to hogs, pens, and litter. Use 2 tablespoonfuls per animal and dilute with talc for thorough coverage. One treatment is usually sufficient. Repeat in 10 day intervals or as needed. Do not treat pigs under 1 month of age. Avoid contamination of feed, feed containers, and watering troughs.

SHEEP – LICE AND KEDS: Apply 2 tablespoons per animal and make thorough application to entire animal. Treatment just after shearing is preferred. Repeat after 14-21 day intervals if needed. Do not apply within 14 days of freshening. Do not treat animals under 1 month of age.
