#### FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a Physician at once in all cases of suspected Parathion Poisoning or signs of poisoning (See Physicians' Note), including dizziness, cramps and tightness in the chest. Don't wait for a doctor but give 1-2 tablets (each 100 grains) at once.

Remove patient immediately from the area where Staypar contaminated clothing and wash the skin clean with plenty of water to remove all traces of Staypar. Wash contaminated clothing by hand or soapy water. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

#### NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PATIENT

Physicians' Note: Watch for dizziness, headache, nausea, vomiting, blurred vision, tightness in the chest, pupils, incontinence, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.

Treatment: Give atropine, 1-2 mg. (1/40 grain) tablets 1-2 tablets at once and every hour as required until patient is conscious. Tablets may be required during the first 24 hours. Never give atropine by postural drainage. Administer 1-2 mg. of atropine if necessary. Observe patient carefully for 48 hours. Repeat atropine treatments may be required when atropine produces very small doses of any clinical signs of inhibition. About 1 hour of rest for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed in blood tests.

#### DO NOT GET IN EYES, ON SKIN, ON CLOTHING

Wear clean rubber gloves, goggles and clean waterproof or freshly laundered protective clothing (coveralls, rubber boots, cap, etc.). Destroy and replace gloves frequently.

Bury soilage; wash area thoroughly with a solution containing 1 lb. soda ash per gallon of water to which a water-soluble wetting agent has been added.

Bags: Destroy empty bags by burning.

### FIRST AID TREATMENT
