

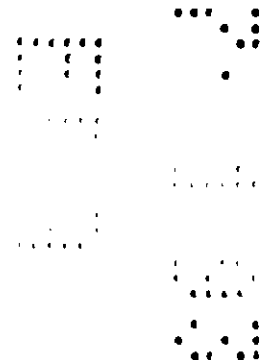

### **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

#### **Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals**

**OTHER USE PRECAUTIONS:** Do not allow drift onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants since injury may result. Do not pour spray solutions near these plants. Whether using a hose-end sprayer or pressure-sprayer, do not use fine sprays because they can drift and cause damage to non-target plants. Coarse droplet sprays are less likely to drift. Use only lawn-type sprayers. Do not spray on bentgrass, carpetgrass, centipedegrass, dichondra, St. Augustinegrass nor on lawns or turf where desirable clovers are present. Do not spray roots of trees and ornamentals. **WHERE TO USE:** DANDELION AND BROADLEAF WEED KILLER may be used on bluegrass, bermudagrass and zoysiagrass lawns, vacant lots, playgrounds and other similar areas where HARD-TO-KILL weeds are present DANDELION AND BROADLEAF WEED KILLER is especially effective against these weeds such as SHEEP SORREL, KNOTWEED, SPOTTED SPURGE, CHICKWEED, OXALIS AND HENBIT.

**WHEN TO USE:** Spray at any time during the growing season when weeds are actively growing. Treat chickweed, henbit, wild onion and garlic in the fall and again in the spring if needed. On new grass lawns wait until the turf has reached a height of 2 inches before making an overall spray treatment. Spot spray treatments may be made at any time with a small pressure sprayer. Wait 2 weeks before seeding or planting stolons plugs, or sprigs. Do not spray weeds during drought periods unless the lawn has been thoroughly watered 2-3 days before.

**HOW MUCH TO USE:** DANDELION AND BROADLEAF WEED KILLER contains dicamba plus 2,4-D.

The maximum application rate to turf is 1.1 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

**TO SPRAY ENTIRE LAWN:** One pint covers up to 5,500 Sq. Ft. of lawn area. Dilute with water as indicated below.

\*For Lawn Hose End Sprayers dilute the amount shown above with enough water to fill the sprayer bottle to the 2 gal. level for 300 sq. ft. to the 6 gal. level for 1300 sq. ft. to the 12 gal. level for 2700 sq. ft.

**TO SPOT-SPRAY WEEDS:** Lawn hose end sprayers are not suited for this type of treatment. Use a pressure sprayer.

Mix 8 fl. oz. of this product in 3 gals of water and spray each weed to point of spray run-off.
