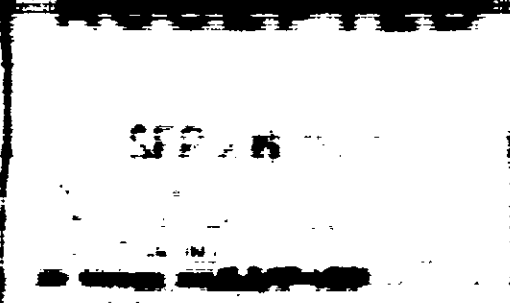

FACE FLIES, HORN FLIES, HOUSE FLIES, AND STABLE FLIES: Use a hand sprayer or container with a spray nozzle to apply the spray to the head of the animal. For Face Flies, spray the forehead, taking care to avoid the eyes. For Horn Flies, direct the spray to the head of the animal. For cattle, make 2 applications of the spray per day. The first application should be in the evening.

STABLE FLIES: Apply at same rate and timing as for Horn Flies; however, direct the spray to the leg areas making sure to directly spray the ankles.

NOTE: Do not exceed the maximum dose of 2 ounces per animal daily. For effective fly control, Vapona Show-Coat Dairy Cattle Spray should be used as directed. It is highly toxic to flies but loses its strength within the day as most dairy cattle sprays. For this reason, no insecticidal residue is built up. A well planned Fly Control Program that includes the 2 spray applications per day as directed will give results.

WARNING: May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not inhale spray mist. Avoid contact with skin; wash thoroughly after using. This product is an organic phosphate which is a cholinesterase inhibitor and if poisoning should occur, CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY, ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL.

CAUTION: Empty containers should be destroyed; never re-use. Either punch holes in them and burn them (stay out of smoke) or bury them with any spillage or spray wastes in non-crop areas away from water supplies.

Do not allow the spray mist to contaminate milk or milking utensils. Cover feed and feed troughs or remove before spraying.

This material is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate any body of water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.
