Request for Alternate Formulation of the Confidential Statement of Formula

2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid EPA Registration Number 2217-455

Application Submission dated May 13, 2005

The label and CSF referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that the following revisions are made:

- 1. Add the following sentence to the end use of "For Agricultural Use": The maximum seasonal application rate to forestry sites is 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site.
- 2. Under the Storage and Disposal section, the heading must be Pesticide Storage.

One copy of the label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of the final printed supplemental label before the product is released for shipment. The accepted CSFs dated October 24, 2005 supercede previously accepted Alternate and Basic CSFs for this product.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). (1) AGRICULTURAL CROPS

- a. Grain and seed crops: corn, sorghum (milo), soybeans (preplant), rice, small grains (wheat, oats, barley, rye), fallow cropland, crop stubble.
- b. Crops grown exclusively for seed or planting: grass seed crops, sod production.
- c. Sugar crop: sugarcane.
- d. Forage crops: annual grasses, perennial grasses, rangeland (grasslands providing forage for grazing animals), pasture (grassland or grasses providing forage suitable for grazing livestock).
- e. Small fruits: orchard floors (pome fruit, citrus fruit, stone fruit, filbert, and nut crops), strawberry, blueberries.

(2) TERRESTRIAL NONFOOD CROP AND NONCROPLAND AREAS

- a. Ornamental trees, shrubs and vines, lawn and turf grasses: yards, cemeteries, parks.
- b. Uncultivated agricultural areas: fence rows, rights-of-way, barrier strips, established perennial grasses such as the Conservation Reserve Program.
- c. Uncultivated nonagricultural areas: yards, lawn, turf, cemeteries, parks, airports, recreation areas (including golfcourses), fairgrounds, roadsides, rights-of-way (highway, railroad, and utility), industrial sites, and paved areas.

(3) AQUATIC WEED CONTROL.

- Agricultural irrigation water and ditches, agricultural drainage water and ditches.
- b. Lakes, ponds, reservoirs, impounded water, streams, rivers and canals, swamps, marshes, wetlands, estuaries, tidal marshes.
- c. Commercial and sport fish-bearing waters.
- d. Industrial ponds

(4) FORESTRY.

- a. Forest trees, plantings, forest tree nurseries.
- b. Forest site preparation.
- c. Forest roadsides, tree and brush control.
- d. Established conifer release and tree injection treatments.
- (5) Uses for which US EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and
- (6) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MUP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with US EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration of their formulated product.

MANUFACTURER TO FURNISH USER WITH COMPLETE DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN ACCORDANCE WITH HIS FORMULATIONS.

This product can only be used to formulate pesticide products if the labeling contains the following information and/or revised use directions. All products manufactured for residential and turf (excluding sod farms) uses after June 15, 1994, must contain the revised label language below. All other products (i.e., agricultural, industrial and aquatic), manufactured after October 23, 1993, must bear the revised label language below.

All products released for shipment on or after October 1, 2005 must bear revised labeling complying with the maximum application rates for general non-crop sites; tree, brush and woody plant control on rights-ofway; and forestry use patterns other than site preparation, if registered for such uses.

Wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking or drinking. Wash hands and arms before using toilet. After work, remove all clothing and shower using soap and water. Do not reuse clothing worn during the previous days mixing and loading or application of this product without cleaning first. Clothing must be kept and washed separately from other household laundry. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower."
- c) The maximum application rate to pasture and rangeland is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) two pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site.
- d) The maximum application rate to forestry site preparation is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) four pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum application rate to all forestry sites is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 4 pound 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site.
- e) Reentry interval is required and should be in accordance with the Worker Protection Standards, 40 CFR Parts 156 and 170.

2. FOR INDUSTRIAL, NON-CROP and AQUATIC USES

- a) Clothing Requirement Statements: "When mixing, loading or applying this product or repairing or cleaning equipment used with this product, wear eye protection (face shield or safety glasses), chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, and shoes. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow, and temple protection. For aerial applicators in an enclosed cockpit and applicators applying this product from a tractor that has a completely enclosed cab, eye protection is not required."
- b) Personal Hygiene Statements: "Wash hands, face and arms with soap and water as soon as possible after mixing, loading or applying this product. Wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking or drinking. Wash hands and arms before using toilet. After work, remove all clothing and shower using soap and water. Do not reuse clothing worn during the previous day's mixing and loading or application of this product without cleaning first. Clothing must be kept and washed separately from other household laundry. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower."
- c) The maximum application rate to general non-crop sites is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 2 pounds for 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site. The maximum non-crop application for tree, brush and woody plant control on rights-of-way is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 4 pounds of 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site. The maximum seasonal application rate to non-crop sites is 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site.

3. FOR RESIDENTIAL AND TURF USES

a) Clothing Requirement Statements: (1) For All Granular Products: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, and shoes." (2) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other noncommercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course, amine products applied in liquid form and carrying "CAUTION" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, and rubber gloves. (3) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod by homeowners and other noncommercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course, amine products applied in liquid form and carrying "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, rubber gloves, and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow, and temple protection. (4) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod homeowners and other noncommercial users, and for mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course; acid, sodium salt, and ester products applied in liquid form and carrying "CAUTION" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, and chemical-resistant gloves. (5) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other noncommercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course; acid, sodium salt, and ester products applied in liquid form and carrying "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, chemical-resistant gloves, and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow, and temple protection. (7) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by commercial mixer/loader/applicators (except when the product is to be applied to a golf course), all products applied in liquid form and carrying "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word only must bear the following language: "When mixing, loading, or applying this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, chemical-resistant gloves, and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow, and temple protection.

- b) Personal Hygiene Statements: (1) For All Granular Products: "After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water."; (2) For All Liquid Products: "After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower."
- c) The maximum application rate to turf is the lower of (1) existing application rate on currently registered label or (2) two pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.
- d) The following reentry statement must be included: "Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment area until spray has dried or dust has settled."

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets.
