

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NEVER USE OR STORE IN OR AROUND THE HOME

FLY MAGGOTS: To control fly maggots in such maggot breeding areas as garbage dumps and manure piles, mix 1 quart of Vapona Insecticide with 7 1/2 gallons of water and apply the diluted solution in a coarse, wet spray. Apply 2 quarts of the diluted solution to each 100 square feet.

ANIMAL BUILDINGS: To control flies, mosquitoes, roaches, ants and cockroaches in Horse Barns, Calf Barns, Cheetar Sheds, Milk Sheds, and Piggeries, mix 1 quart of Vapona Insecticide with 7 1/2 gallons of water, and apply the diluted solution in a coarse, wet spray. Apply 1 quart of the diluted solution to each 100 square feet. Treat around doors, windows, and openings in walls and window sills. Animals may be present during treatment. Do not contaminate feed, drinking water, or milking utensils.

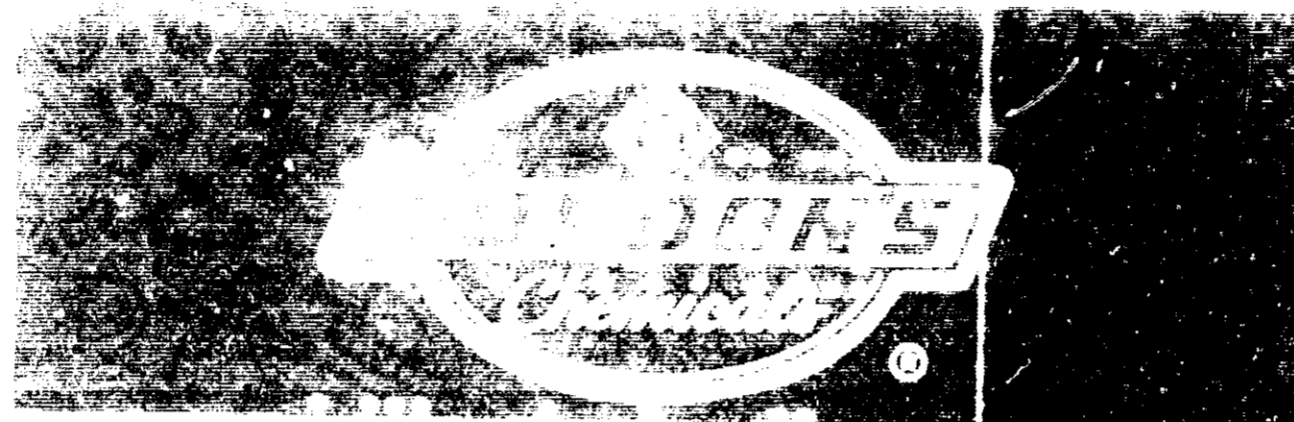
DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE: For control of House Fly, Horn Fly, Stable Fly, Face Fly, and Mosquitoes, mix 1 gallon of Vapona Insecticide with 7 1/2 gallons of water. Apply the diluted solution of this diluted solution per animal in a mist spray to fly with hand or automatic sprayer. Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the eyes, but do not spray directly into the eyes. Do not apply more than 2 fluid ounces per animal per day.

DOG KENNELS: Apply 1 quart of Vapona Insecticide to window sills and ledges, and to the floor and down dog boxes, mix 1 quart of Vapona Insecticide with 7 1/2 gallons of water and spray 1 quart of the diluted solution to each 100 square feet.

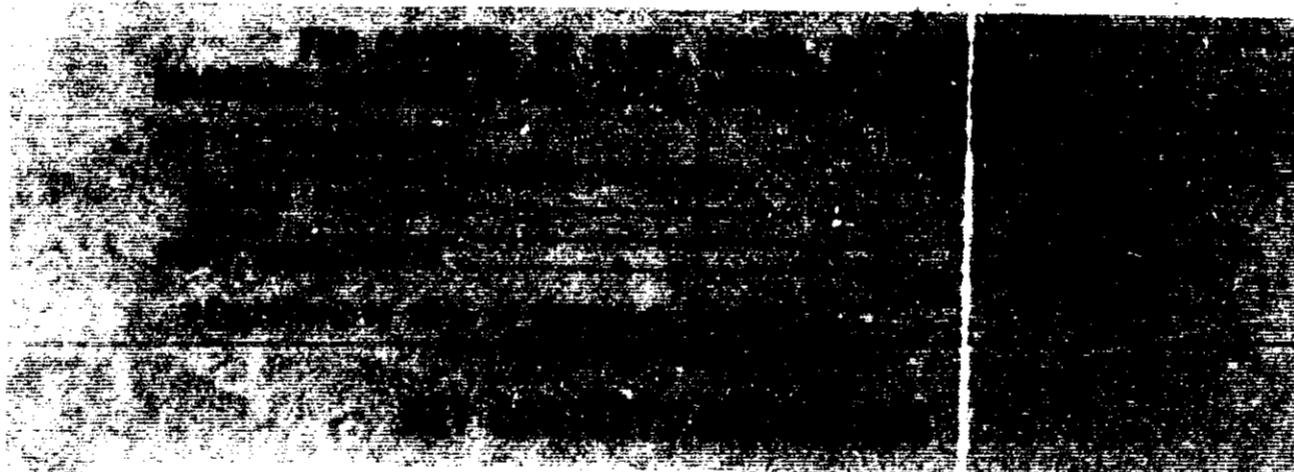

DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin or eyes. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing. Do not breathe fumes. Avoid breathing of spray mist. In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water and get medical attention. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing, and goggles when handling concentrate to prepare emulsions. During fogging or mist spraying applications, wear a mask or respirator approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for use with DDVP. Wash thoroughly after handling, and before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use. Do not contaminate feed, feedstuffs, or drinking water. Do not use inside homes or where milk is stored or processed.

IF POISONING SHOULD OCCUR, CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT, WATER, FOOD,

ANTIDOTE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT: Atropine is the emergency antidote for Vapona poisoning. Consult your physician about obtaining an adequate supply of 1-100 grain Atropine Tablets. **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.**

INTERNAL: If the material has been swallowed, induce vomiting immediately. This may be done by introducing a finger into the throat or by giving warm salt water. If the patient is unconscious, give a glass of water. **NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.**

EXTERNAL: If the material has been spilled on the skin, immediately remove the patient from the vicinity of the spill. Wash and remove all contaminated clothing, and wash your hands and face with running water. If the material gets into the eyes, flush immediately with running water for at least ten minutes.

IF WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR: Administer two 1-100 grain tablets of atropine immediately. **NEVER ADMINISTER ATROPINE UNLESS WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR.** See warning symptoms below. Keep patient lying and quiet. Start artificial respiration immediately if breathing ceases. Transport the patient to the nearest hospital. Atropine is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN—WARNING SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include: drowsiness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, dry mouth, pinpoint pupils, salivation, convulsions, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Repair equipment and containers used for application of wastes by burying in deep, dry land away from water supplies.

Do not reuse container. After emptying, break and bury in the ground. F.P.A. Reg. No. 2217-463-7A
