**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**AERIAL APPLICATION:** Use recommended amount of ALFA-SPRAY for each specific crop with a minimum of 3 gallon of water per acre consistent with crop growth and good coverage.

**ALFALFA:** For control of alfalfa weevil, spittlebug, leafhopper and aphid.

**FIRST CUTTING:** Apply 2-3 quarts per acre as soon as weevil damage appears in the field. Early application is desired to control the weevil when they are small. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not apply after full bloom.

**STUBBLE SPRAYING:** In areas where weevil appears at cutting time. Remove the first cutting and apply 2-3 quarts per acre to the stubble to control weevil larvae and adults.
