DIRECTIONS

HORSE SPRAY is especially designed for direct use on horses. It kills and repels horn flies, stable flies, house flies, gnats, and mosquitoes, and provides protection against these insects during and after spraying. ALSO KILLS HORSE FLIES THAT ARE HIT BY THE SPRAY.

Spray once daily using 1 to 2 ounces per animal applied as a light mist. May be used twice daily at the rate of 1 oz. per animal.

If possible, treat animals daily before pasturing. Horse Spray may be sponged directly on to flanks and belly where flies may be most troublesome. Repeat as needed. Wear a rubber glove when using sponge. Apply sparingly.

As a space spray, to achieve quick knockdown and kill of flies, gnats and mosquitoes, spray at the rate of 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet. Keep all windows and doors closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Remove animals during this treatment.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed.

Avoid wetting the hides of animals. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not contaminate feed, food or water receptacles.
